LA SALITA - ROMA 1957

...Nearly all of these last paintings came to life between late spring and late autumn 1956. They are images in perfect equipoise on the apex of vertiginous, flaming color, yet mitigated by a sense of general and synthetic harmony which brings back measure, unity, and intellectual grace. These images do not just crop up from occasional pretexts, but come rather from real contacts with the landscape between the plains and hillsides of Bologna, reflected in color emotions and in strong frames of ideal architecture. From some titles of these paintings you can divine the moment or place of their inspiration. There is in these paintings the moment, the spark, the tension and the intoxication of his impressions. But as I have said on other occasions, it is not so much the presence of reality itself (which here is less solid and more metaphoric than in his earlier works) which gives a special quality, but rather the poetic figure of that reality which the artist has unleashed through his sensitivity. This poetic figure is not based on an aspect of reality, which already inspires feelings of diffidence, but rather on an evocation of fantasy almost beyond imagination: flashes of insight freed from the yoke of appearances — the true rôle of the artist —, passion and knowledge, and not the confused darkness of a tumultuous subconscious, qualities which reestablish on another plain an explicit plastic truth: indeed, the essential function of the artist. Is it possible, therefore, to insist on sharply upsetting the elements of a stylistic approach if it is not to bring forth new poetry of nature, still obscured to the senses; or could it be merely to express a blind dispersion based on the first impulses of instinct?
